We’re excited to announce Good Shepherd has upgraded our mobile app! Vanco, our eGiving provider, has launched an updated mobile app called Vanco Mobile Faith Engagement to replace GivePlus Mobile.

You can download the app for free from the App Store or Google Play. Type in “Vanco” in the search bar and look for the choice with the half purple V. From there, you can make a one-time donation or set up recurring giving right through the app. Just select your fund and amount, enter a payment method and complete the donation.

Vanco has extended the timing on the switch to Dec. 31. However, it is best to download the new app as soon as possible. Thank you!
