

## TESTIMONIAL

As I reflect upon all that Good Shepherd Lutheran Church has done for me over the years I get very emotional (in a good way).

I started coming to Good Shepherd when the church I was going to no longer was meeting my needs. I knew I needed a change. But thoughts of, Would I find another congregation that would accept me and love me? Would I get the spiritual nourishment that I was craving? I prayed that God would lead me to another congregation.

At that same moment in time my daughter was at the age when she was ready to go to preschool. I remember my father saying that he passed a sign that had a lamb on it advertising a preschool at the local church on Pearl St.

God is so Good because here was my answer to prayer! A new church for me and a Christian-based preschool for my daughter.

Pastor Don came to my home and met with me and immediately I knew this was where I would start coming to worship. He even said that they

were looking for someone to teach Sunday school if I wanted!!! (I did take him up on his offer and was blessed beyond words and taught for over 8 years here at Good Shepherd)

Roxann was amazing and kind and my daughter thrived in this preschool. I cannot believe that was 25 years ago!! Pastor Don and the congregation walked along side with me during major events in my life.

I became a member here! My daughter was baptized here. The congregation stuck together when our country was attacked on 9/11! My husband and I were married here by Pastor Don! The congregation walked along side of me during my father's eight year battle with dementia/Alzheimer's and then passing. My husband and I helped with the building's expansion project.

Pastor Don and the congregation walked along side us when my husband was stricken with cancer and then passed away. (Pastor Don met with my husband's parents the week after he died and provided invaluable council to them) The funeral that Pastor Don and the congregation held for us was beautiful; the luncheon after was so helpful.

When I was passionate about organ donation, Pastor allowed me to speak to the congregation on the topic. When I was asked to host a prayer group at my home it was such a blessing to me! Here I thought opening my home would help people have a place for a bible study and it ended up blessing me and teaching me so much about the love of Jesus. It was so timely and wonderful. Pastor Don also was open to me when I came to him and asked if we could host a grief share program once a week here at the church. I felt that this was something our church was lacking in and that the community of those grieving a loss could benefit from. Of course, he said yes and with the help of my co facilitator we were able to help and minister to many grieving in the community.

I cannot tell you of the number of people whom I have met over the years and have become lasting friends with. I am truly blessed to have found a home here with Good Shepherd. Watching the Church grow and change and offer so much to the community is something I am very proud of.
