11/17 And Jesus answered him, "It is written, "You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only shall you serve." Luke 4:8
Pray for the courage to take an honest look at whom or what you are serving in your daily life.

11/18 Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe. Heb 12:28 Tell God how awesome He is.

11/19 Let everything that has breath praise the Lord! Praise the Lord! Psalm 150:6Look around at your fellow created creatures and observe how they are praising God.

11/20 Not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near. Hebrew 10:25
Pray for opportunities to encourage others today.

11/21 About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. Acts 16:25 Sing, hum, or whistle a hymn of praise to God wherever you are. (Someone might be listening and ask about your joy!)
