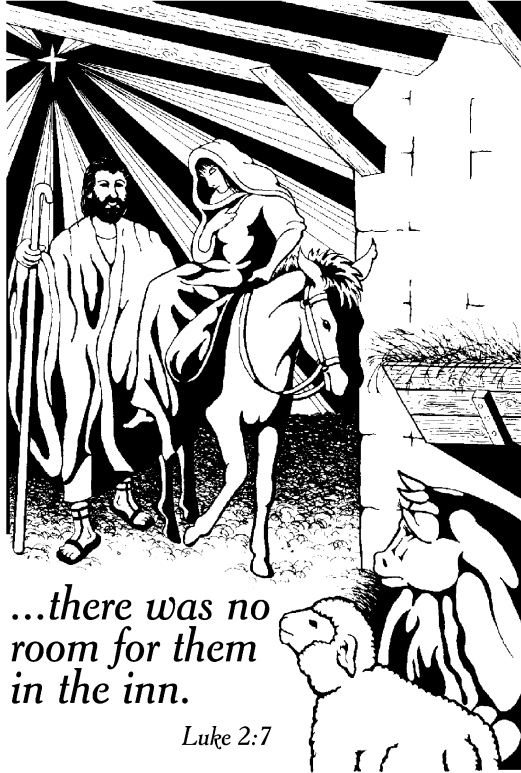

THE HYMN - "WHAT CHILD IS THIS"

Pastor: We begin our worship in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Cong: Amen.

THE CONFESSION

Pastor: We are here tonight to prepare for the coming of our Lord. We are here because we know that we would be unprepared for the birth of a Savior if He were born to us today. We are here to celebrate that God, through His Spirit, calls us out of our sins and makes our lives straight to Him.

Let us make confession in our hearts of all that separates us from God. Let us bring forth all thoughts, words and deeds with which we offend God.

(A time of silence is observed for each to think about and make confession.)

Cong: Holy Father, we confess our sins of pride, our sins of foolishness, our sins of selfishness, our sins of intolerance, our sins of wickedness, all our sins which separate us from each other and keep us from your kingdom, when your Son comes again to proclaim it to us. All these we confess to you, Father, and ask your forgiveness.

Pastor: By God's command, and because He has sent His Son into this world to take upon Himself our sins, I announce to you the grace and forgiveness of God. Be assured of His love and heed His call: Go and sin no more. Amen
