

3/14 For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 1:18

Ask God to empower you to bring the word of the cross to those who do not believe.

3/15 Looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2

Pray that, like Jesus, you will look beyond the cross to see joy.

3/16 By canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This He set aside, nailing it to the cross. Col 2:14

Thank God for nailing some of your specific debts to the cross.

3/17 And being found in human form, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Philippians 2:8

Pray for the humility to be obedient.

3/18 He himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed. 1 Peter 2:24

Pray that you will die to sin and live to righteousness.

3/19 And through Him to reconcile to Himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of His cross. Colossians 1:20

Thank God for the only true peace, given to us by Jesus' sacrifice.

3/20 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him may have eternal life. John 3:14-15

Pray that someone you know will look to the cross of Christ and live.
