

5/9 Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing. 1 Thessalonians 5:11

Pray for someone who needs encouragement.

5/10 Let no corrupt talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. Ephesians 4:29

Ask God to guard your lips that they speak only what encourages others.

5/11 Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. Show hospitality to one another without grumbling. As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace. 1 Peter 4:8

Thank God for the good gifts He has given you and pray that you will use them to serve others.

5/12 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. Galatians 6:2 **Ask God if there is a burden you can bear for someone.**

5/13 But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. Hebrews 3:13

Pray that your words of encouragement may help someone avoid sin.

5/14 Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another. Proverbs 27:17 Pray that you will become better disciples by helping one another grow.

5/15 That their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and the knowledge of God's mystery, which is Christ. Colossians 2:2

Pray that God will knit us together in love.
