



8/8. *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9*

Confess your sins and embrace God's forgiveness.

8/9 *Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.*

James 5:16

If you are able to, confess your sins to someone you trust and ask for his/her prayers.

8/10 *Preach the Word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching.*

2 Timothy 4:2

Pray that God will use the gifts He has given you to spread His Word.

8/11 *Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into Him who is the head, into Christ. Ephesians 4:15*

Ask God to help you grow to be more like Jesus.

8/12 *And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, correcting his opponents with gentleness in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth. 2 Tim 2:24-25*

Pray that you will lead others to Jesus through your kindness.

8/13 *Let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins.*

James 5:20

Ask God to help you lead wanderers back to Him.

8/14 *Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. 1 Peter 4:8*

Pray that love is the guiding principle in our relationships.
