9/22 Whoever is not with Me is against Me, and whoever does not gather with Me scatters. Matthew 12:30

Pray that you will be a gatherer, not a scatterer.

9/23 Gather to Me My faithful ones, who made a covenant with Me by sacrifice!
Psalm 50:5

Thank God that He invites us to come to Him.

9/24 Assemble the people, men, women, and little ones, and the sojourner within your towns, that they may hear and learn to fear the Lord your God, and be careful to do all the word of this law and that their children, who have not known it, may hear and learn to fear the Lord your God as long as you live in the land that you are going over the Jordan to possess. Deuteronomy 31:12-13

Pray that people will learn to fear the Lord our God.

9/25 Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. Exodus 20:8
