

FORGIVE US, RENEW US, LEAD US

P: We begin our worship in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen

P: The time of Christ’s coming is at hand; the day is drawing near.

C: His name is called “Jesus” for he shall save his people from their sins.

P: Lest that day surprise us unprepared, let us confess our sins to God our Father, imploring him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us His promised forgiveness.

(Silence for meditation and self-examinations)

P: Most merciful God,

Go to the Apple Store or Google Play and search for "[Vanco Mobile Faith Engagement](#)" (the half purple V) to download for free. Then enter Good Shepherd; next tap *Donate Now*. 3. Choose a fund and a preset amount or enter another amount. You can make a one-time donation or set up recurring giving right through the app. Select *Add* to add another fund or move forward to the payment information. 4. Scan or enter your card or bank account information. 5. Review your donation summary then select *Complete Donation*. Or if you prefer to have your gift automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account, check that box on the right side of your connection card, "Automating My Giving" or contact the church office and we will provide you with the form you will need to complete in order for us to set that up. Please remember that the Give Plus Mobile App will no longer be available as of April 30.
