

5/1 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will exalt you. James 4:10
Ask God to show you the areas of your life in which your humility can serve others.

5/2 Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." 1 Peter 5:5
Pray about clothing yourself in humility and how that might improve your relationships.

5/3 Before destruction a man's heart is haughty, but humility comes before honor. Proverbs 18:12
Ask God to remove any haughtiness in your heart.

5/4 Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight. Romans 12:16
Ask God to correct you if you are wise in your own eyes.

5/5 Finally, all of you, have unity of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind. 1 Peter 3:8 Take an honest look at the times you judge and criticize others in your mind. Ask for forgiveness and help to change.

5/6 Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, for all His works are right and His ways are just; and those who walk in pride He is able to humble. Daniel 4:37 Thank God that He will help you learn to be humble.

5/7 He leads the humble in what is right, and teaches the humble His way. Psalm 25:9
Pray that you will be humble and open to all God has to teach you.
