



7/31 Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. Romans 8:26

Acknowledge your weakness and need for the help of the Holy Spirit.

8/1 And He who searches hearts knows what is in the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God. Romans 8:27

Thank God that the prayers of the Holy Spirit focus on the will of God.

8/2 But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit. Jude 1:20

Thank God for your prayer partner, the Holy Spirit, who will help you to grow in faith.

8/3 And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, to be with you forever.

John 14:16

Give thanks that the Holy Spirit will be with you forever.

8/4 Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died – more than that, who was raised – who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. Romans 8:34

Thank Jesus for interceding for us too!

8/5 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. Romans 8:14

Pray that you will release your need for control and be led by the Holy Spirit.

8/6 First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of truth. 1 Timothy 2:1-5

Pray for our leaders that their work will enable us to lead peaceful, quiet lives.
