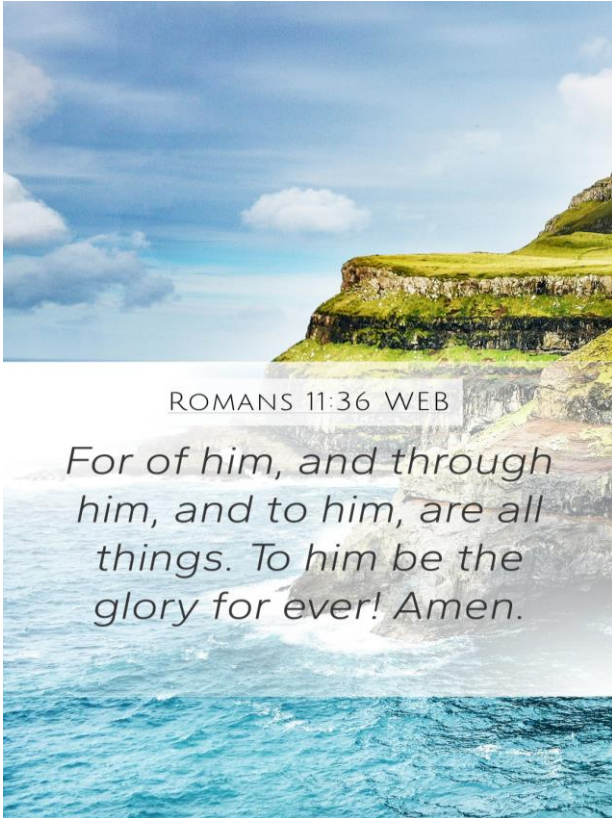

THE CONFESSION

Or if you prefer to have your gift automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account, check that box on the right side of your connection card, “Automating My Giving” or contact the church office and we will provide you with the form you will need to complete in order for us to set that up. Please remember that the Give Plus Mobile App will no longer be available as of April 30.

PRAY AROUND THE SCHOOLS

It's that time of year again! Students head off to an exciting new year. Teachers, other staff and support persons as well. Prayer cards are offered, available at the Host Station, to help each of us focus on prayer for a particular student, age or grade and/or district for the upcoming school year.

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

School supplies have arrived in the stores – it must be time to think about Operation Christmas Child! We will be packing boxes for boys age 10-14. Here are the items we try to pack for each boy: small balls, solar calculators, pens, pencils, pencil sharpeners, erasers, rulers, scissors, 1 subject spiral notebooks, markers, colored pencils, toothbrushes, toothbrush cases, bar
