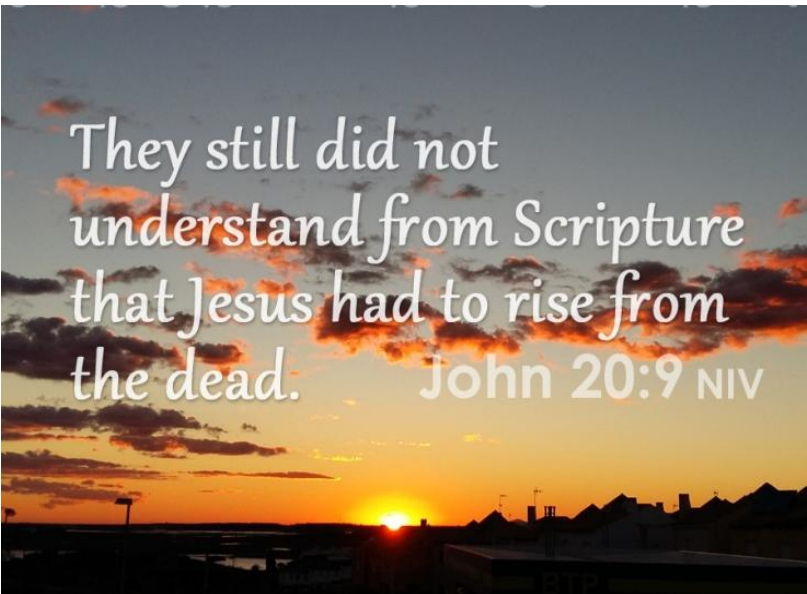

THE SERVICE OF THE EUCHARIST

THE GREAT THANKSGIVING*

P: The Lord be with you.

C: And also with you.

P: Lift up your hearts.

C: We lift them up to the Lord.

P: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

C It is right to give him thanks and praise.

P: It is indeed right and good that we should at all times and in all places offer thanks and praise to you, O Lord, Holy Father, almighty and ever living God. But chiefly we are bound to praise you for the glorious resurrection of our Lord; for he is the true Passover Lamb who gave himself to take away our sin, who by his death has destroyed death and by his rising has brought us to eternal life. And so, with Mary Magdelene and Peter and all the witnesses of the resurrection, with earth and sea and all their creatures, and with angels and cherubim, and seraphim, we praise your name and join their unending hymn:

**C: Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord, Lord God of power and might:
Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the
highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.**

Or if you prefer to have your gift automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account, check that box on the right side of your connection card, "Automating My Giving" or contact the church office and we will provide you with the form you will need to complete in order for us to set that up.
